APPLICANTS' QUALIFICATIONS

1. For graduates holding Master's degree, applicant must hold a Master of Science in Dermatology or equivalent to science related field or in the fields that are approved by the University Council with GPA no less than 3.00.
2. For graduates holding Bachelor's degree, applicant must hold a Doctor of Medicine degree from the university or institutions that are approved by the University Council with GPA no less than 3.50.
3. Thai applicant must have a medical license for at least 1 year and have successfully practiced as an intern for at least 1 year prior to the application date.
4. Applicants from prior criteria must have one of English proficiency scores (TU-GET/ TOEFL/ IELTS) in accordance to the university's announcement for international program admission. The English proficiency scores must not exceed 2 years counting from the date of the English test and the admission date.
5. Foreign students must pass the aforementioned qualification and the scholarship committee.
6. Other qualifications must be in accordance to Thammasat University's regulation regarding graduate studies, 2561 B.E.
7. For applicants who are currently studying in the Master of Science in Clinical Dermatology at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University.

STUDY PLAN

Master of Science Program in Dermatology is a bilateral program and all classes are conducted in English. Throughout the study, the classes are taught in working hours and the program has one study plan.

APPLICANTS' QUALIFICATIONS

The qualifications of applicants must be in accordance with rules and regulations of ThammasatUniversity for Graduate Studies, 2562 B.E. (Items 22-23) as follows.

1. Applicant must hold a Doctor of Medicine degree from either domestic or abroad university which is approved by the University Council.
2. A cumulative grade point must not be lower than 2.75.
3. Thai applicant must have a medical license (2 years of experience) and have successfully practiced as an intern at least 1 year prior to the application date.
4. General qualifications must be approved by the program's committee.
5. Foreign applicants' qualifications must be accordant with criteria no. 1, 2, and 4
