Thammasat University is accepting new application for Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual) 6 years Programme Thammasat University undergraduate level for academic year 2016, 2nd round.

3. Applicant qualification of Doctor of Dental Surgery's (Bilingual) 6 years Programme

3.1 General qualification

- 3.1.1 Able to communicate well in Thai Language
- 3.1.2 Having high responsibility, details oriented, and be honest throughout the entire process of selection, written examination, health status evaluation, and oral examination.

3.2 Specific qualification

- 3.2.1 Must be Thai nationality with age not over 28 years old (counting to 15 August 2016, the date when the semester begins)
- 3.2.2 Education qualification of the applicant must meet one of the following criteria no. 3.2.2.1 – 3.2.2.3.
 - 3.2.2.1 Graduated from Mathayom 6 or equivalent. Or studying at Mathayom 6 and will graduate within this semester, according to the ministry of Education in the field of sciences-mathematics. **OR**
 - 3.2.2.2 Graduated from international school or studying and will graduate within this semester at the international school in Thailand equivalent to Mathayom 6, equivalency of knowledge certificate received from the Educational Information and Registry Group of the Office of Educational Testing (OET), Committee of Fundamental Education, Ministry of Education. **OR**

3.2.2.3 Graduated High School from aboard or studying at high school aboard, in the level equivalent to Mathayom 6, in the major of Sciences and Mathematics. Received equivalency of knowledge certificate from the Educational Information and Registry Group of the Office of Educational Testing (OET), Committee of Fundamental Education, Ministry of Education. Candidate must present the original documents on the date of the interview and health examination.

3.3 English proficiency qualification

Applicant must show their English proficiency by submit one of the following English proficiency results and presents the original document on the date of the health examination, and oral examination

3.3.1 IELTS – (The International English language Testing System) Academic type with score no lower than 6.5 and in all of the skills (Listening, Speaking, Reading, and Writing) must not get score below 6.5 or result of IELTS UKVI equivalent to, **OR**

3.3.2 TOEFL score; paper-based test, not lower than 550, computer-based test score, not lower than 213, internet-based test score, not lower than 79 **OR**

3.3.3 TUGET score; paper-based not lower than 550

* English Proficiency examination results must within 2 years starting from the date the examination taken place until interview day.

3.4 Sciences and Mathematics competencies

3.4.1 Applicant from section 3.2.2.1 must have the GPA from Mathayom 4 to 5 no lower than 2.50 (If applicant has graduated high school the total score of GPA will be use). All subject result should not be lower than grade C, in any case that the applicant received lower than grade C in any subjects the final GPA must be no lower than 3.00.

3.4.2 Applicant from section 3.2.2.2 and 3.2.2.3 must presents one of the follow examination results:

3.4.2.1 IGCSE/GCSE International Certificate of Secondary Education, consist of, at least 3 subjects among Biology, Chemistry, and Mathematics and Physics. One of the 3 subjects result must not be lower than grade A **OR**

3.4.2.2 IB (International Baccalaureate) Standard Level or Predicted IB scores with Chemistry, Biology and Physics in group IV or Mathematics in group V. One of the subject result must not be lower than 6. **OR**

3.4.2.3 SAT II results in subjects of Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics or Physics. One of the subject most not be lower than 525. **OR**

3.4.2.4 Examination result in Sciences and Mathematics from abroad which equivalent to Mathayom 6 level and one of these subjects Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics or Physics subject's result must not be lower than grade A.

3.4.2.5 Other examination results will be considered by Admission Committee

3.5 Additional Qualification for Dentistry selection process

Specific provision for candidates who wish to study Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual Program) is conduct in appropriate manner from 3 factors, which are (1) will not cause harm to patient, (2) will not cause harm to student itself, and (3) will not become obstacle for studying, according to these:

3.5.1 Have the qualification to work at government selection or in any department of government after graduated. Being able to sign one side agreement or optional agreement with the government, according to the rules and regulations from the government and the university.

3.5.2 Applicant for Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual Program) must be in good health, free from disease, and symptoms from disease or disabilities that will become an obstacle for learning, operating, and practicing medicine according to these:

3.5.2.1 Suffering from severe psychological problems which could do harm to themselves or other, for example: Psychotic Disorders, Mood Disorders, Severe Neurotic Disorders, Personality Disorders, especially Antisocial personality Disorders ,or Borderline Personality Disorders. This including other types of psychological problems that could become obstacle to studying, operating, and practicing.

3.5.2.2 Suffering from Infectious diseases at critical stage which is able to harm themselves or other, can result in permanent disability. This also could become obstacle to studying, operating, and practicing.

3.5.2.3 Suffering from noninfectious diseases at a stage where it becomes obstacle to study, which may cause harm to themselves or others.

3.5.2.4 Having a disability at the point where it becomes obstacle to studying, operating, and practicing.

3.5.2.5 Suffering from one of the following Visual impairments:

- Severe Color blind on both eyes, which already been test and examine thoroughly
- The level of sight on good eye is worsted than 6/12 or 20/40 when already fixed

3.5.2.6 Having hearing disability in both ears, with the average hearing at 500-2,000 hertz, higher than 40 decibel. Speech discrimination score lower than 70 causing from sensor neural hearing loss.

If present later that the applicant is ineligible for any of the above requirements, given false information, or intentionally concealing crucial information. The applicant will be disqualified from Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual Program) even if they had passed the examination.

4. Selection methods / Selection criterias

Will be according to the Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual Program) Admission committee whom appointed by Thammasat University. The committee will consider from:

- 4.1 Written examination - Basic Sciences knowledge of Chemistry, Biology, and Physics that can be used in the study of dentistry. The examination conducts in English.
- 4.2 Health examination
- 4.3 An oral examination conducts in English, to select the appropriate applicant

The decision of the Admission Committee will be considered final.

5. Conditions for Applicants who wish to apply Doctor of Dental Surgery (Bilingual Program)

- 5.1 Is not currently studying Doctor of Dental Surgery (for those who wish to study Doctor of Dental Surgery) at other university/government institution (except when the applicants have resigned before April 11, 2016).
- 5.2 Cannot request to transfer to Doctor of Dental Surgery (Thai Program) which also opens by Faculty of Dentistry at Thammasat University.
- 5.3 Applicant must undergo testing and certify that he/she is qualified in accordance with the notification that applications are being accepted for the Program. Should the university, in its own investigative inquiry, discover that an applicant possesses qualifications in any one area that are not consistent with the aforementioned notification, it shall be understood that the applicant is unqualified and thereby ineligible to enter the program of study. If, in this instance, the application fee has already been paid, the fee shall not be refunded to the applicant under any circumstances whatever.

6. Acceptance of applications

6.1 Application can be accepted through the online application system via website www.cicm.tu.ac.th beginning from April 11, 2016 until May 09, 2016.

- Begins accepted Application online on April 11, 2016 at 09:00
- Closed accepted application on May 09, 2016. at 24:00

Payment can be made through the Teller Payment system of the Siam Commercial Bank (Nationwide) from April 11, 2016 until May 10, 2016.

- Payment can be made during business hours of the Bank

6.2 Application Process

6.2.1 Reading in details the application process as announced. (Please print out/read and carefully scrutinize on your own all pertinent data and information in order to maximize the benefit you will derive from it.)

6.2.2 Applicant will register and save their application through the online application system at the Internet address www.cicm.tu.ac.th within the specified date. (Please

enter your application information solely on your own and check it carefully in order to maximize the benefit you will derive from it.)

6.2.3 The applicant must print out an application form, which he/she fills out completely on the online application system which will be available over the internet. He/she should check whether his/her application information is correct prior to making payment for the application fee. Applicant is urged to carefully enter the information, and correct any incorrect data if happen so. The university will give priority to the application data that has been saved through the online system.

6.2.4 Applicant will bring the application form which he/she has printed out over the online application system to the Siam Commercial Bank (Nationwide) in order to make payment for the application fee. Payment will be made within the dates specified according to the assigned application fee rate, together with the 15 Baht for bank service fee. **Should any applicant fail to submit the application fee through the Teller Payment System of the Siam Commercial Bank (Nationwide) within the specified date, the contents of the online application which the applicant submitted over the internet shall be then declared null and void.**

6.2.5 Once the bank has received and made a record of payment for the application fee, the bank will then issue a proof of payment for the application fee received and return the application form to the applicant, which he/she may retain as proof of having applied for the program of study. The bank will perform these actions when the fee has been paid in full. It will then be understood that the application process is complete and, accordingly, the university will not consider refunding to the applicant either the application fee or the entrance-examination fee under any circumstances whatever. (Please check that the proof of payment for the application fee is completely consistent with the contents of the application form and safeguard it for its evidentiary value. Immediately report any discrepancies to the bank for your own protection.)

6.2.6 Applicant can check the applicant list and the status of payment 3 business days after the payment was made (not including the weekend and public holiday) at online application www.cicm.tu.ac.th by selecting

Undergraduate → Admission → Doctor of Dental Surgery → Application for Admission →, then select checking “status” button.

6.2.7 If the applicant name is not in the list of eligible applicants to take the written examination, seat plan or wish to correct the spelling of his/her given name, surname, national identification number and/or date of birth, which the applicant cannot correct on his/her own through the system, the applicant can download a form in order to file an appeal with a copy of his/her national identification card attached, specifying the desired changes in detail. 6.2.8 If the applicant wants to cancel the application of the program selected and select new program. Applicant can do this process online only as following steps:

6.2.8.1 Cancel the previous application

6.2.8.2 Applying the new program you want to select and follow the process.

6.2.8.3 In order to cancel program or select new program applicant must do the process before the deadline date.

6.2.9 In the case that applicant uses the application form that has already been cancelled to pay, there will be no effect what so ever. Due to the application has already been cancelled, which makes the form void, and the information will not be used. Please be cautious and check before make the payment that the form you have is the correct one.

7. Documentation and examination materials

7.1 **On the written examination**, the applicant must present a valid national identification card or valid passport. Failure to do so will result in the applicant being barred from the examination.

7.2 **On an oral examination**, the applicant must bring original documentation and copy to be hereafter shown to the proctors.

7.2.1 Certificate of English proficiency test result

7.2.2 Diploma; or high-school record through to the sixth year or high-school equivalency test results; or certificate from the international schools of Thailand which has been found commensurate with the program of study and has been certified by the Ministry of Education. A student who has graduated from a school in a foreign country must present a valid equivalency of knowledge certificate received from the Educational Information and Registry Group of the Office of Educational Testing (OET), Committee of Fundamental Education, Ministry of Education in order to verify he/she is qualified in accordance with the notification. An applicant who is eligible to enter the five-year program of study must bring his/her original transcript and one copy showing the applicant's educational background in order to verify he/she is qualified in accordance with the Notification.

7.2.3 If the documentation of an applicant is found to be less than complete, the applicant will be immediately declared ineligible for selection into the program.

8. Fees

8.1 Application fee: 2,000 Baht; Bank service fee: 15 Baht (to be paid on the date of application through the Teller Payment System)

8.2 Oral examination and Health examination fee: 3,000 Baht (to be paid on the day of the Health examination, following announcement of the written examination results). Candidate who taking the Health examination must be qualify in every requirements according to the announcement.

9. Announcement of eligible applicant for the written examination with seating will be announced on May 17, 2016

The university will announce the list of the eligible applicants and seating via website, www.cicm.tu.ac.th .

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11. Announcement of eligible applicant for the health examination and oral examination: May 27, 2016

12. Health examination: May 31, 2016

Health examination is assigned to be on May 31, 2016, between 08:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Applicants must report themselves at 08:00 a.m. and will start the health examination at 08:30 a.m., at Piyachart Building, 2nd floor, Room 230, Thammasat University (Rangsit Campus). **Applicant must not take any food or drink after midnight before taking the blood test.**

13. The Oral examination: June 01 – 02, 2016

Applicants who are eligible for the Oral Examination will need to bring documentation and application materials and submit these to the proctors on June 01 – June 02, 2016, at 08:00 a.m.. At Ratchasuda Building, 3rd Floor, Room 303, Thammasat University (Rangsit Campus) (Numbers applicable to those eligible for the Oral Examination, including room numbers, will be announced at a later time.) Requirements for the examination are as follows:

Oral examination: 08:30 a.m. (all applicants starting at the same time)

On June 01 – June 02, 2016, those who are eligible for the examination will report at 08:00 a.m. and submit their documentation and application materials to the proctors as following

1. Payment receipt with online application paper printed from www.cicm.tu.ac.th
2. Identification card (original and a copy signed CERTIFIED TRUE COPY)
3. Certificate of English proficiency test result (original copy and 1 copy signed CERTIFIED TRUE COPY)
4. Certificate presenting the standard knowledge of Sciences and Mathematics, which show the grade of Chemistry, Biology, and Mathematics or Physics (original copy and 1 copy signed CERTIFIED TRUE COPY)
5. Diploma; or high school record through to the sixth year or high school equivalency test results; or certificate from the international schools of Thailand which has been found commensurate with the program of study and has been certified by the Ministry of Education. A student who has graduated from a school in a foreign country must present a valid equivalency of knowledge certificate received from the Educational Information and Registry Group of the Office of Educational Testing (OET), Committee of Fundamental Education, Ministry of Education in order to verify he/she is qualified in accordance with the notification. (Both original and copy)
6. Certificate of Surname Change Registration, when the name on the document does not match. (Both original and copy)

* If the documentation of an applicant is found to be less than complete, the applicant will be immediately declared ineligible for selection into the program. The Original documents will be return once the selection processes are finish.

14. Announcement of applicant accepted into the program of study: June 10, 2016

Thammasat University will announce the applicant who have been eligible to study at Faculty Dentistry on June 10, 2016, through websites , www.cicm.tu.ac.th, www.dentistry.tu.ac.th only. Applicants who has been accepted must declare and affirm his/hers intention to enroll and signed the contract before he/she can become a dental student.

15. Declare intention to enroll and sign agreement to be Dental Student: June 16 - 17, 2016.

Those whom selected are to report and receive documents to sign as agreement to become Dental Student, on June 16 - 17, 2016. The selected applicants must pay the deposit tuition fee of 100,000 baht, at Faculty of Dentistry, Ratchchasuda Bldg., 8th Floor, Thammasat University (Rangsit Campus).

In the case of the eligible applicants do not show up for declare intention to enroll and sign agreement to be Dental Student on date and time assigned by Thammasat University and do not inform by letter within the time period, this will be considered as waiver and Thammasat University will call the next applicant on the list.

Those whom selected are to report and receive documents to sign as agreement to become Dental Student thereafter he/she would like to cancel the agreement. If, in this instance, the part of the tuition fee has already been paid, the fee shall not be refunded to the applicant under any circumstances whatever.

16. Ranking the basic knowledge of foreign language for eligible applicants

The university has arrange that all eligible applicants who passed the admission examination must take the competency of English language and discretion thinking test made by Thammasat Competency Test Center (TCTC) to evaluate the competency of the students before and after the study. The evaluation result will be used to set up the education plan and subjects, or ranking the knowledge of foreign language for all students. Details regarding date, time, and location of the test will be announced later.

17. Enrollment to be a student

Applicants who have confirm their rights to enroll with the university will receive all the documents on orientation day, (Date and location will be announced), and the University will announce the student's identification number with details of enrollment, including activities schedule for new students later at www.reg.tu.ac.th

18. Conditions of enrollment

18.1 Must passed the all the examinations from each program

18.2 Must completed high school/Mathayom 6 or equivalent, if it should later appear that an applicant lacks any one of the qualifications stated above applicant shall be declared ineligible to enter into the program.

Should the Thammasat University, in its own investigative inquiry, discover that an applicant possesses qualifications in any one area that are not consistent with the aforementioned notification, it shall be understood that the applicant will be disqualified and thereby ineligible to enter the program of study. If, in this instance, the application fee has already been paid, the fee shall not be refunded to the applicant under any circumstances whatever.

18.3 Those that already enrolled with Thammasat University and later show to have been enrolled at other university at the same moment will be removing of the enrollment. According to the rules and regulations of the university.

18.4 Those that already registered as a student of Thammasat University. If the university detected later for any false document(s) or being forged in the application or registration the university will withdraw the name out of the enrollments, and prosecuted according to law.
