High-risk areas

With a recent spike in Covid-19 cases in Samut Sakhon we urge all of the CICM community to be aware of designated high-risk areas as announced by the Ministry of Public Health. Please be aware of symptoms including fever, cough, sore throat, lack of taste, nasal congestion, or runny nose. If you suspect you have traveled on a flight, bus, or were in close proximity to a positive case, please contact the Ministry of Public Health immediately. Those who have been to Samut Sakhon since December 4, 2020 must self-declare and self-quarantine at home for 14 days before being eligible to return to campus.

Elective for third-year medical students

Out of an abundance of caution, the Bumrugrand International Hospital visit has been postponed indefinitely. Students scheduled to go to Chonburi will proceed as scheduled tomorrow, December 21, 2020.

Classes are still on schedule

Classes will be conducted as usual. Students must wear masks, receive a temperature check, and wash their hands with alcohol prior to entering campus and during their time in class.

Returning to campus

International students returning from overseas MUST comply with state quarantine requirements.

We encourage you to monitor developments through the Ministry of Health and WHO websites. We will need your help. A few easy things we can all do include:

- Wash your hands for 20 seconds
- Use hand sanitizer
- Avoid shaking hands
- Disinfect frequently touched objects using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe
- Stay home
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- We encourage social distancing when outside of the home at all times, this includes leaving 2 meters of space between individuals.
- Local transmission is still occurring, we encourage students to avoid crowded locations, bars, and pubs at this time.
