Thammasat University has been opening an application for special undergraduate program, the Bachelor of Science in Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program) at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University, Academic Year 2020. Details are as follows.

1. Location of Study

The Bachelor of Science program in Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program) takes place at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University (Rangsit Campus).

Remark: 1. In case the number of accepted students does not meet the criteria, the number of candidates can be added in the next round.

2. The college has opened the admission via TCAS2 Quota, TCAS3 Direct Admission, and TCAS4 Central Admission. Applicants can see more details at student.mytcas.com.

3. Applicants' Qualifications

Applicants' qualifications must be in accordance with Thammasat University's Regulations regarding Undergraduate Studies, 2561 B.E., Item 14, details as follows.

1. Applicants must graduate from high school level equivalent to Mattayom 6 or currently studying in this level (1st semester) majoring in **SCIENCE-MATH** and will graduate in the current academic year approved by the Ministry of Education **OR** graduate from international school from domestic/overseas countries with education level comparison guideline by Thammasat University, 2562 B.E.
2. Applicants must not being students of other higher educational institutions unless those are open universities or online curriculum towards academic degree.
3. Applicants must not have any diseases which will be obstacles to study (do not have severe color blindness on both eyes).
4. Applicants must not being morally guilty or possess severe misbehavior.

5. Have one of the following English test results.

In case English proficiency does not meet the above criteria, applicants must have at least one of the following results.

Applicants must have cumulative GPA score of English Language from high school level no less than 3.00, then can be accepted, however, language proficiency development must be shown during study.

English proficiency test scores must not exceed 2 years counted from the test date until the date of application.

If found later that candidates do not meet any requirement aforementioned or given false information or intentionally given false information, they will be disqualified from study in the Bachelor of Science program in Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program) regardless whether they have successfully passed the admission.

Decisions of admission judges will be final.

5. Bachelor of Science in Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program)

5.1 All applicants have only one right to select the program under specified criteria. After the program application has been confirmed, applicants cannot return to reapply in the next round of admission. If they wish to reapply, they need to disclaim their rights in the current round through CUPT TCAS system within specified timeline. However, applicants can disclaim their rights only once. Any process done outside the timeline will be null.

5.2 Candidates must check and guarantee themselves that they meet the requirement in the admission announcement. If the university later found that any candidates do not meet the requirement in the admission announcement, they will not be permitted to study for they do not meet the requirement. No refund will be issued in any cases regardless whether they already registered.

9. Application Fee

9.1 Application fee: 1,000 THB and bank fee (if any)

9.2 Interview examination fee for the Bachelor of Science program in Cardio-Thoracic Technology (International Program): 1,500 THB (pay on the interview date after announcement of eligible candidates has been made)

10. Study Intention Report

All successful candidates who have confirm their rights through CUPT system must report their intention to study in the program within specified date and time (detail will be announced later), an amount of 30,000 THB of the deposit fee payment will be made at Chulabhorn International College of Medicine (location will be announced later at www.cicm.tu.ac.th)

Successful candidates who do not report themselves and do not present possible evidence will be considered as disclaimer to register.

11. Conditions of Successful Candidates to Register as Students

11.1 Candidates must pass all the admission process to study in Thammasat University.

11.2 Candidates must already finished high school (Mattayom 6 or grade 12) or equivalent. If the university later found that the candidates did not finish this level, the university will not accept those candidates for study.

If Thammasat University later found that successful candidates do not meet any of the aforementioned requirements, the students' rights to study will be voided and no refund will be issued in any cases.

11.3 Candidates must not already have their names in other universities or institutions in Thailand. If the university later found that candidates have their names in other universities or institutions, their names will be excluded from the student registration immediately according to the regulations regarding undergraduate study.

11.4 For candidates who already registered as the students of Thammasat University, if the university later found that the candidates gave forgery document during registration or application process, they will be excluded from being the students of Thammasat University and legal actions regarding criminal laws will be taken against them.

Thammasat University's Announcement
on Thammasat University's Guidelines on Equivalency of High School Qualifications,
2562 BE

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With reference to the University Executive Board's approval of Thammasat University's Guidelines on Equivalency of High School Qualifications in the meeting 9/2562 on 22 May 2562 BE;

By virtue of Section 39 of the Thammasat University Act 2558 BE; be it, enacted by the Rector, as follows:

1. This announcement is called "Thammasat University's Announcement on Thammasat University's Guidelines on Equivalency of High School Qualifications, 2562 BE".

2. Be it enacted as follows:

2.1 Equivalency of qualifications under Paragraph 3.1.2 regarding the British education system, Paragraph 3.3 regarding the New Zealand's education system and Paragraph 3.5 regarding international programs from other countries shall come into effect from the academic year of 2562 BE onwards.

2.2 Equivalency of qualifications under Paragraph 3.1.1 regarding the British education system, Paragraph 3.2 regarding the American/Canadian education system and Paragraph 3.4 regarding the International Baccalaureate (IB) programs shall come into effect from the academic year of 2563 BE onwards.

3. The equivalency of high school qualifications shall observe the following criteria:

3.1 British education system

3.1.1 Applicants shall have GCE 'A' Level results in 3 subjects, with grades A*-C; or

3.1.2 Applicants shall have Cambridge Pre-U results in 3 subjects, scoring at least M1 or D1-D3 in each subject.

3.2 American/Canadian system

Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2560 BE shall have GED results in 5 subjects with the total score of no less than 2,250 points, with at least 410 points in each subject.

Applicants taking the GED tests after May 2560 BE shall have GED results in 4 subjects, scoring at least 165 in each subject. This qualification is equivalent to high school diploma in Language Arts or Art-Maths (as previously called) programs only.

3.3 New Zealand's system

3.3.1 Applicants shall have the New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) under supervision of the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) with no less than 80 credits, consisting of

- Subjects in Level 2 or higher, comprising of no less than 60 credits; and
- Subjects in Level 1 or higher, comprising of no less than 20 credits.

English for Speaker of Other Languages (ESLO) is also a subject included in the consideration.

Applicants shall have an NCEA level 2 certificate, a Record of Achievement, and a certificate from New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) confirming the levels, number of subjects and number of credits of each subject.

All in all, the criteria under Paragraph 3.3.1 apply to high school graduates from New Zealand from the academic year of 2553 BE; or

3.3.2 Applicants shall have the New Zealand National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) under supervision of the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) with no less than 60 credits from at least 5 different subjects in Level 2 or higher and 2 compulsory subjects; namely:

- English (literacy) in Level 2 or higher, at least 4 credits
- Mathematics (numeracy) in Level 2 or higher, at least 4 credits

English for Speaker of Other Languages (ESLO) is not included in the consideration.

Applicants shall have a Record of Achievement, and a certificate from New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) confirming the levels, number of subjects and number of credits of each subject.

All in all, the criteria under Paragraph 3.3.2 apply to high school graduates from New Zealand from the academic year of 2552 BE;

3.4 International Bacculaureate (IB) Programs

3.4.1 Applicants shall have a high school diploma from a school in Thailand approved by the Ministry of Education; or

3.4.2 Applicants who graduated from overseas shall have an IB diploma: that is; having a total score of no less than 24 points from 5 subjects and 1 elective subject, and shall have passed the evaluation on Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Action & Service (CAS) under the criteria of International Bacculaureate Organisation (IBO); or

3.4.3 Applicants have IB Diploma Course Results (IBCR) of at least 5 different subjects and receiving no lower than Grade 3 in each subject.

3.5 International programs from other countries outside Paragraphs 3.1-3.4

Please check the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications announced on 18 January 2545 BE.

3.6 For applicants who graduated or obtained test scores prior to 1 August 2562 BE, the Council of University Presidents of Thailand's Criteria on Equivalency of High School Qualifications in University Admission, 2562 BE are applied.
