Scholarship Availability for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Students, Academic Year 2022

Chulabhorn International College of Medicine is pleased to announce the requirements for applicants interested in available scholarships for the Academic Year 2022.

1. Applicants Eligibility

1.1 Be an international undergraduate student identified from the Thammasat International Student Recruitment, year 2022 and selected to enroll in one of the following programs:

- Doctor of Optometry (International Program)
- Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program)

1.2 Be a postgraduate student or an international postgraduate student identified from Thammasat International Student Recruitment, year 2022 and selected to enroll in one of the following programs:

- Integrative Medicine (International Program)
- Bioclinical Sciences (International Program)
- Social Gerontology (International Program)

1.3 Postgraduate students are required to have a GPAX of at least 3.00 from their previous bachelor's degree and 3.25 for master's degree.

1.4 Have a minimum English proficiency test score of one of the following:

IELST > 6.5

TU-GET (Paper-based > 550), (Computer-based > 79)

TOEFL ITP (paper base > 550), (Computer-based > 213), (Internet-based > 79)

either one may be used.

1.5 No history of disciplinary action.

1.6 Not a current scholarship recipient.

2. Scholarship Coverage

Tuition fee exemption until completion of degree requirements will be provided to 7 recipients as listed:

- 2.1 2 Doctor of Optometry (International Program)
- 2.2 2 Cardiovascular and Thoracic Technology (International Program)
- 2.3 1 Integrative Medicine (International Program)
- 2.4 1 Bioclinical Sciences (International Program)
- 2.5 1 Social Gerontology (International Program)

Remark: The scholarship recipient is required to report to the scholarship committee 14 days in advance before leaving for The Kingdom of Thailand for any reasons (e.g. study/research abroad) if the planned travel is 4 weeks or more.

3. Regulations and Conditions

3.1 Students will be exempted from tuition fees for the 1st semester until the completion of degree requirements.

3.2 Recipients who violate the contract of agreement* e.g. withdrawing from study, or fail to present at every academic semester progress meetings with scholarship committee are required to pay in full, the amount of tuition fee accrued including interest* which is calculated as the academic semester/year since obtaining the tuition fee exemption until the academic semester/year that the recipient withdrew from study.

3.3 The recipient must accrue a minimum of 70 volunteer hours per academic year and must show evidence to the committee review at every semester to maintain eligibility.

3.4 The recipient must submit grades for each semester to the scholarship committee within the deadline announced by the Office of International Affairs. Academic achievement (GPA) should be no less than 2.75 for Bachelor's degree, no less than 3.25 for Master's degree and no less than 3.50 for Doctoral degrees.

3.5 The recipients, who study in the master's programs, are required to have at least 1 national or international thesis publication that must be published in the database of TCI-1 / ISI/ Scopus. For the recipients, who study in the doctoral level, students are required at least 1 international thesis publication that must be published in the database of ISI/Scopus. Please be noted that the recipients studying in both master and doctoral programs are required to specify the grant support to be from "Chulabhorn International College of Medicine, Thammasat University" in your thesis when sent for publication.

If the recipient does not meet the aforementioned qualifications, the committee will consider termination of the scholarship for the following semester. If the student is a recipient of a co-requisite scholarship through Thammasat University's International office, that student will lose the ability to continue to obtain living expenses as outlined by the university.
