1. Applicants must register into the TCAS system on the website <http://student.mytcas.com> as the Council of University Presidents of Thailand has designed. The system will open for registration from 5th January 2021. Applicants must sign up in the system before submitting the applications to the university.
2. Accept only BMAT results that took place in August and October 2019 and November 2020. Applicants must select Thammasat University within Cambridge's system to send their BMAT results automatically. Otherwise, applicants must bring their original documents from the test center to submit at Thammasat University. Please note that copies of documents received from the website are not allowed to be verified.
3. Applicants who do not take a medical checkup, CPSQ test, and attend an interview according to the specific date, time, and place shall be deemed disclaimer.
4. Applicants who were selected must confirm eligibility via <http://student.mytcas.com> due to Council of University Presidents of Thailand regulation. (Clearinghouse)
5. In case eligible applicants do not sign the medical student contract with Thammasat University and pay 1st-semester tuition according to the specific date, time, and place shall be deemed disclaimers.
